Dear Governor Wes Moore,

I am politely requesting that you immediately grant a sentence commutation to Harrold Morris III #474175. Harold is serving a 40-year suspended sentence / 20 years mandatory minimum for a non-violent cannabis crime. Harold has exhausted all legal remedies that could lead to his freedom, and the circumstances of his case are unusual due to the current state of the laws.

I am asking that you grant Harold's request for commutation for multiple reasons including; He is a father and is sorely missed by his community, his family, and his friends. He is non-violent and poses zero threat to the community. The sentence he received is disproportionate to the victimless cannabis crimes committed. State-by-state laws in support of cannabis use are rapidly sweeping the nation. Currently, cannabis is legal in 38 states because there are so many scientifically proven benefits of the cannabis plant.
